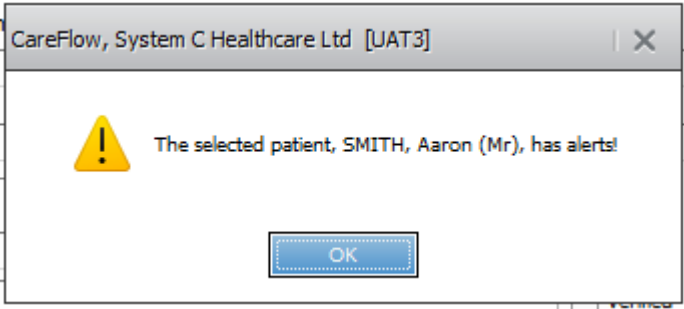
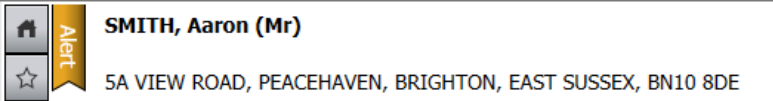
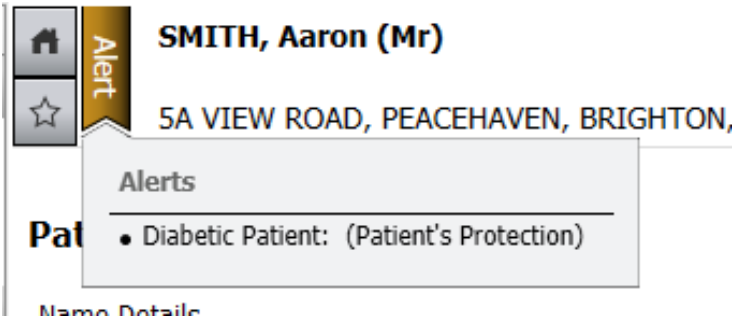
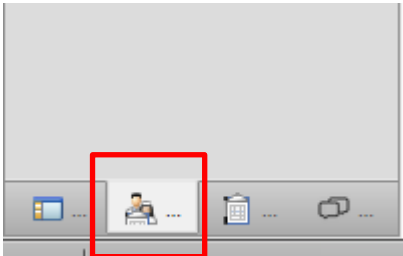
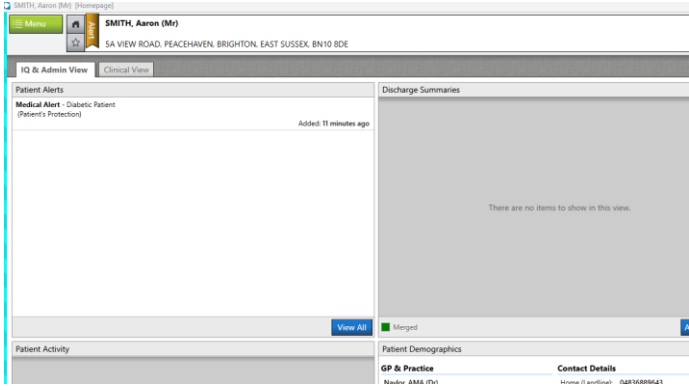
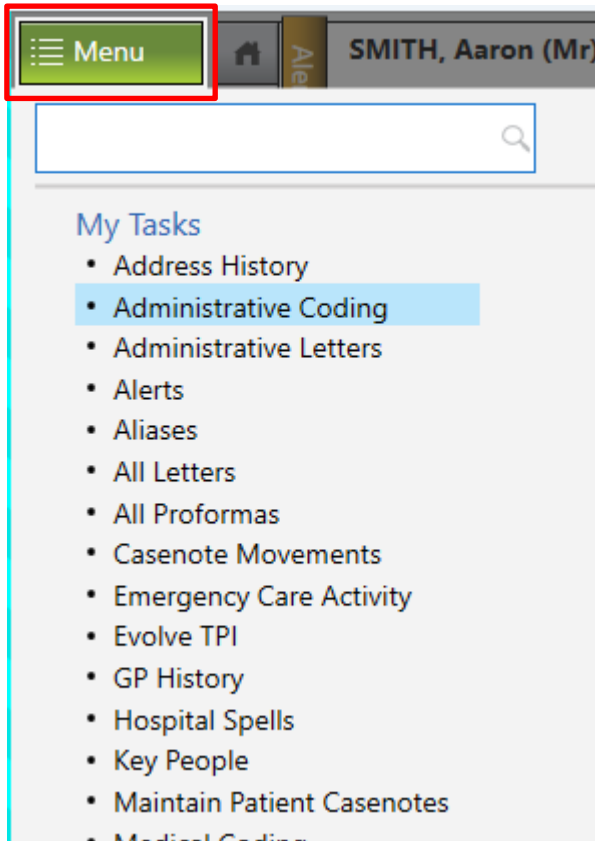


Patient Banner, alerts and banner navigation	
On entering any patient record where alerts are present, you will trigger this warning	
You must acknowledge the warning to proceed to work with the patient record by clicking OK	
The patient banner shows alerts (colour will vary depending on type of alert)	
Other demographics such as; first name, surname, preferred names, date of birth, hospital number, NHS number and current address (or temporary address if active) are all in the banner	
Click the alert banner to see what the alert is	
Patients may have multiple alert types; the colour will match the most severe alert type	
The patient banner will show with red lines and a bold/red date of death if the patient is deceased	

Patient Banner, alerts and banner navigation	
If the patient is deceased the age shown will be as it was at the time death was recorded	
The star icon will add this patient to your favourites	
Favourite patients are accessible via 'My Workspace' in the bottom left-hand corner	
The home icon in the top left of the patient banner opens a summary set of widgets known as the homepage	
Widgets give quick access to discharge summaries, patient activity, demographics and alerts among other things

The green menu button in this homepage view allows for opening other sections not shown in the widgets
