In this scenario, we have already completed the **Death Details** for the patient. Please see the **Record the Death of a Patient in Hospital** guide for more details:



Right-click on the patient and select Discharge Patient



Depending on how the patient was admitted, you will see one of the following discharge screens below:

Add a discharge note if necessary, then click **Save** In **RSCH & PRH**, the patient will now be discharged as deceased.

Click on **Yes** to complete the proforma or **No** to discharge the patient now.
