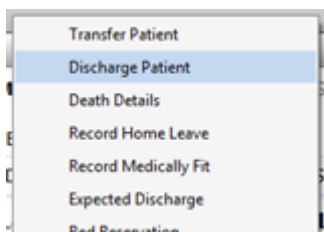
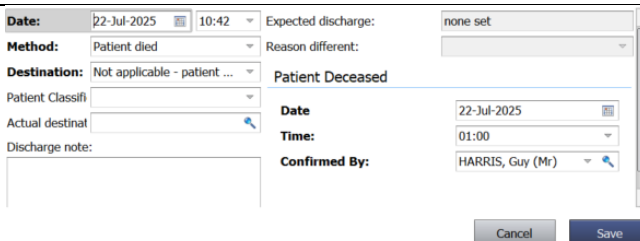
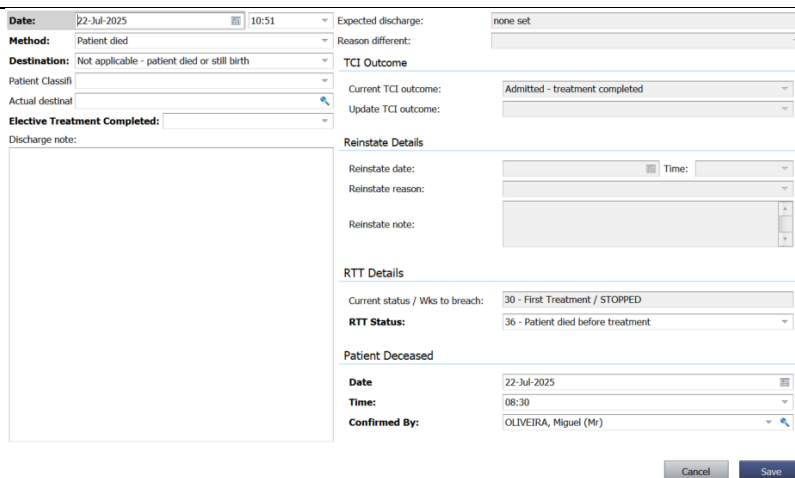
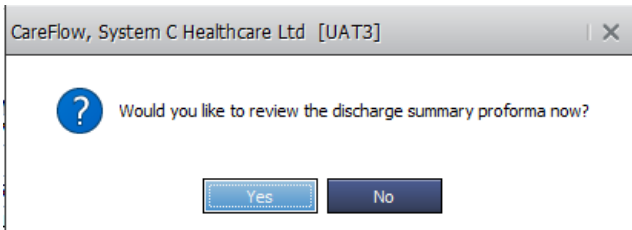


INPATIENTS - DISCHARGE A DECEASED PATIENT	
<p>In this scenario, we have already completed the <b>Death Details</b> for the patient. Follow <b>one</b> of the required steps on the right	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Click on <b>View Patients by Ward</b> and find your ward</li> <li>Click on <b>Inpatient Whiteboard</b> and find your ward</li> <li>Click on <b>View Patient Spells</b> and find your patient</li> </ul>
<p>Right-click on the patient and select <b>Discharge Patient</b></p> 	
<p>Depending on how the patient was admitted, you will see one of the following discharge screens below:</p>	
<p><b>Emergency Admission:</b></p> <p><b>Please note:</b> Back-date/time the Discharge date/time to when the patient died (under Patient Deceased).</p>	
<p><b>Elective Admission – Diagnostic OR Treatment:</b></p> <p><b>Please note:</b> Back-date/time the Discharge date/time to when the patient died (under Patient Deceased).</p> <p>Select <b>Yes</b> or <b>No</b> in the <b>Elective Treatment Completed</b> field.</p>

Add a discharge note if necessary, then click <b>Save</b>	In <b>RSCH &amp; PRH</b> , the patient will now be discharged as deceased.
<b>For SRH, WOR &amp; SOU</b> staff, you will need to complete the discharge summary proforma question below:	
<p>You will be asked “<b>Would you like to review the discharge summary proforma now?</b>”</p> <p>Click on <b>Yes</b> to complete the proforma or <b>No</b> to discharge the patient now.</p>
