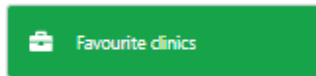


MEDVIEWER – FAVOURITES

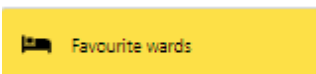

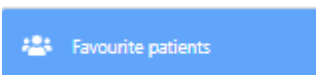
