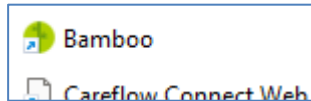
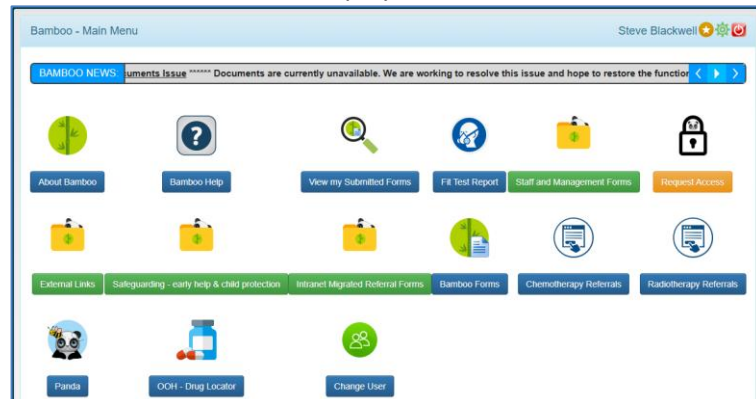


PANDA OVERVIEW

The Bamboo Main Menu displays



The following options are available within Bamboo, with a **single click of the mouse**:

- **About Bamboo** – Contact details of the Development team
- **Bamboo Help** – Release notes, guides and announcements
- **View My Submitted Forms** – Referrals you have raised so you can see the current status
- **Fit Test Report** – Qualitative and Quantitative FIT TEST report for PPE (Personal protective equipment)
- **Staff and Management Forms** – A selection of forms
- **Request Access** – legacy-BSUH access request form to be completed by Line Managers
- **External Links** – includes Anti-microbial reporting
- **Safeguarding** – Early Help & Child Protection – Referral Forms for across the region
- **Intranet Migrated Referral Forms** – Some T&O and MHLT forms
- **Bamboo Forms** – management of the Referrals process by departmental admin
- **Chemotherapy Referrals** – site link to refer to this service and view outstanding ones
- **Radiotherapy Referrals** – site link to refer to this service and view outstanding ones
- **Panda** – to view overview of multiple clinical systems' data for a patient
- **Out of Hours – Drug Locator** – find what wards have which medication out of hours
- **Change User** – Change to a different user, if another user is currently logged in on a generic PC

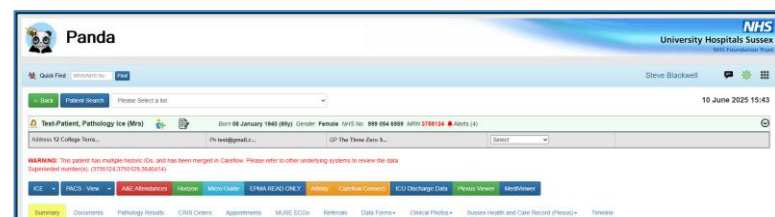


A. Type the patient's Medical Record Number (MRN) or NHS Number into the **Search** box then click **Find**

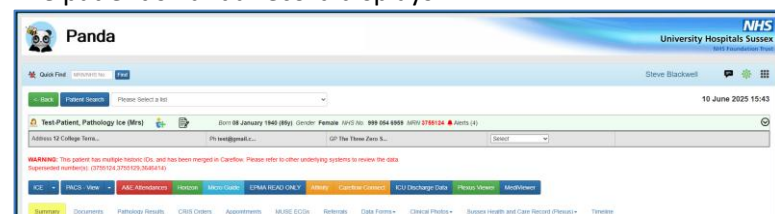

Hovering over *most* icons in this banner will show further details. The **arrow** icon top-right will minimise and maximise the Banner. The EWS icon displays current score & if dropped/risen/same.




Clicking on the button will open up a Viewer which pulls the attendances from A&E, a row for each one:

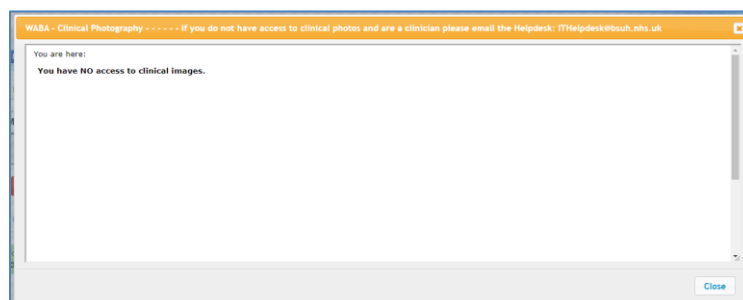

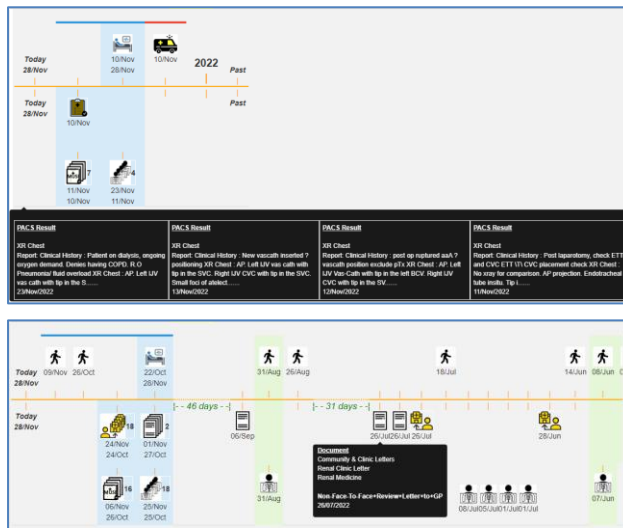
